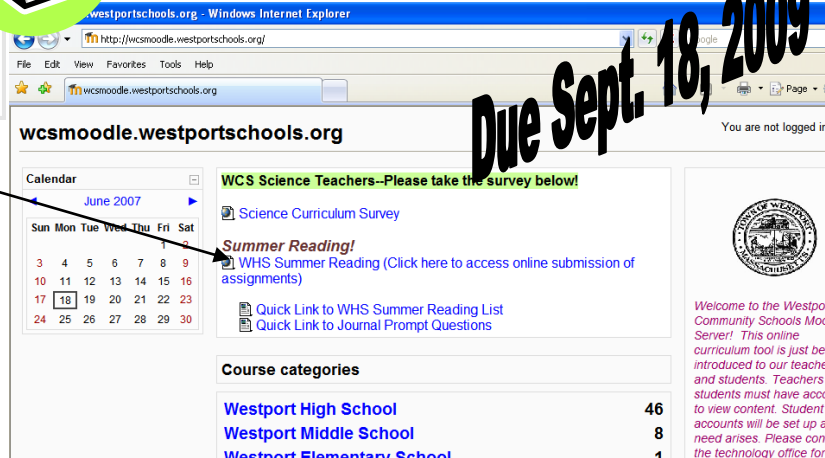
# Westport High School Summer Reading 2009

*If you have forgotten your student ID, it is the 5 digit number that prints out on the top of the report card—the first two digits being your projected year of high school graduation.*

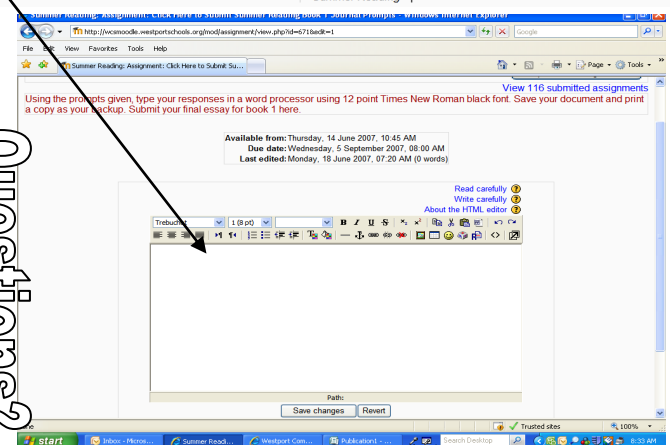
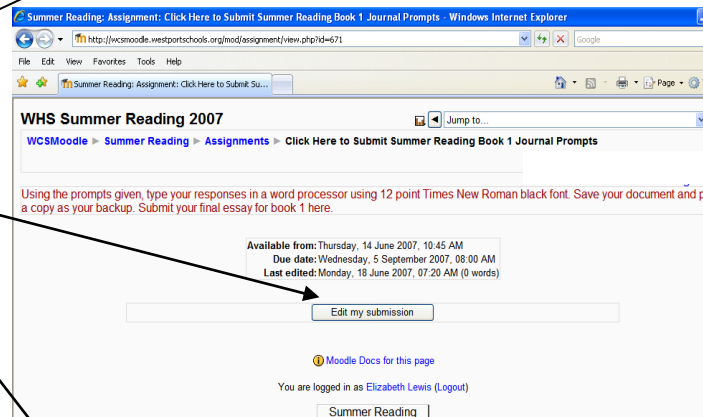
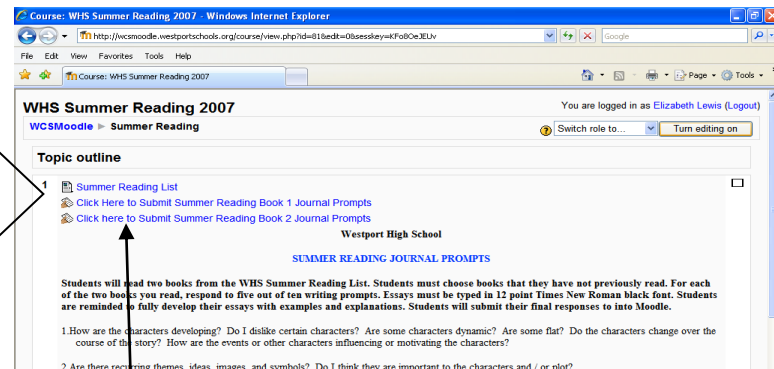
If this is your **first** time looking at the summer reading, you will be asked if you would like to “enroll in the course”—click **YES**.

## Submitting your assignments:

1. Type your response in the word processing program of your choice (Word, WordPad, NotePad, Works, etc.) Remember to **SAVE** your document on your home computer, so that you have a back up of your assignment! **All five journal prompts for the book that you read should be in the same document. Make sure the title and author are at the top of the document**
2. Click on the appropriate link to submit the journal entry
3. Click the **Edit my submission** button
4. A text editing box will appear.
5. **COPY** your journal entry (select, Edit > Copy) and **PASTE** it into the text editing box. (Click in the box > Edit > Paste)
6. Your answer should now be in the box
7. Click the **“Save changes”** button at the bottom of the page
