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# Overview of Westport Junior/Senior High School

Westport Junior/Senior High School is a public school located in Westport, MA, which is in a fringe rural setting. The student population of Westport Junior/Senior High School is 564 and the school serves 7-12. At Westport Junior/Senior High School, 60% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 59% scored at or above that level for reading.

The school's minority student enrollment is 9%. The student-teacher ratio is 11:1, which is better than that of the district.

The student population is made up of 45% female students and 55% male students. There are 52 equivalent full-time teachers and 5 full-time school counselors.

### Test Scores at Westport Junior/Senior High School

At Westport Junior/Senior High School, 60% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 59% scored at or above that level for reading.

Compared with the district, the school did betterin math and better in reading, according to this metric. In Westport, 56% of students tested at or above the proficient level for reading, and 54% tested at or above that level for math.

Westport Junior/Senior High School did better in math andbetter in reading in this metric compared with students across the state. In Massachusetts, 53% of students tested at or above the proficient level for reading, and 49% tested at or above that level for math.


